## League Football returns to West Clandon Rec

The Council has recently funded improvements to the football pitch on the recreation ground. The new goal posts and layout to the pitch have cleared the way to allow Send United Football Club to play its first official league fixture in West Clandon on Sunday 1st March in what will be the first of a regular series of matches in the village. The Club caters for boys and girls from age 5 and above. The pitch at West Clandon will be used for 9-a-side matches for age categories under 11 and 12. Other facilities on the recreation ground could also be due to for an upgrade. Following a consultation reported in previous editions of the magazine, we will be applying for 'Section 106' support to upgrade the equipment in the Play Ground. In the light of the feedback we received we now plan to retain the slide and add a new 'birds nest log swing', web climber and upgrade the safety surfaces.
