THE STREET (A247), WEST CLANDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2017

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of The Street (A247), West Clandon that extends from the southern property boundary of "Parkside", to the northern property boundary of "Clandon Regis". The Order is required to enable Thames Water to make a new water service connection. These works are anticipated to be carried out within one day of the six month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on 8th October 2017. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all time. Access for cyclists, equestrians, emergency vehicles, residents and businesses will be maintained at all times via the signed diversion route which will be: The Street (A247), Clandon Road (A247), London Road (B2215), London Road (A3), Clay Lane (A3100), London Road (A3100), Boxgrove Road (A25) and Epsom Road (A25).
