			is not ideal for HGVs'. The Clerk subsequently emailed DVSA to request re-routing their HGV	
			tests away from The Street. The DVSA responded on 6th October, noting that they had now	
			assessed the route and agree that the road appears unsuitable for large goods vehicles. They	
			will therefore remove all LGV/PCV test routes from Guildford testing centre that include this road	
			with immediate effect. They will also arrange for a poster asking Approved Driving Instructors to	

			avoid using the A247 through west Clandon for LGV sessions.	
5	National Highways & Surrey Highways	22 <sup>nd</sup> September 2023	Request for a police presence to manage the expected gridlock and accidents on the A247 due to the A3 closure 13-16 October. Response received from National Highways on 29 <sup>th</sup> September apologizing for any disruption and noting that the request would be raised with Surrey Police and that it would ultimately be their decision as to what action is deemed necessary.

5	Ockham Parish Council	16 <sup>th</sup> September 2023	OPC are setting up a Flood Forum of local parish councils to meet 6-monthly to discuss common flooding and sewerage issues (SCC, GBC, DEBRA & water companies will also be invited) and inviting us to join.	
6	GBC	18 <sup>th</sup> & 27 <sup>th</sup> September 2023	Notification that, due to the financial issues at GBC, it is proposed to withdraw the parish Council Concurrent Functions Grant Aid (CFGA) going forward. Subsequent notification that GBC's Financial Recovery Plan has now successfully balanced the budget for this financial year and that they have identified enough savings for avoid issuing a Section 114 Notice at this time.	
7	National Highways	20 <sup>th</sup> September 2023	Notification that the full closure of the A3 and diversion route through West Clandon has moved back from the weekend of 29 Sep – 2 Oct to 13 – 16 Oct. This is due to the bridge beams being delayed in their delivery from Ireland.	
8	GBC Planning Enforcement Team	20 <sup>th</sup> September 2023	Update on results of enforcement inspection at The Bulls Head.	
9	GBC	21 <sup>st</sup> September 2023	Announcement that Tom Horwood, Chief Executive of Guildford and Waverley BCs will be stepping down from his role in February 2024.	

10	SWR	21 <sup>st</sup> September 2023	Notification that over 100 of its stations are now 'adopted' by local volunteering groups.
